- A. High proportion of youth population in Pakistan
- B. Unemployment is increasing; ~500,000 graduates are produced each year
- C. Less opportunities for mainstream youth in international job markets
- D. Talented youth is moving out of their communities causing talent drain
- E. Less job opportunities in rural areas, causes migration of youth to urban areas
- F. Fresh graduates need knowledge and skill to become entrepreneur
- G. Need of structured entrepreneurial education and training in HEI,
- H. Hence, the TAKE-UP Project
